

A Basket Full of Apple Riddles



Items used to make this Project:

- CD-120050 Apples Pop-Its™ Dimensional Decorative
- DJ-620035 Sliced Apples Colorful Cut-Outs®
- Basket
- Brass Fasteners

Directions: Students solve riddles. Write a riddle on an upside down Sliced Apples Colorful-Cutouts®. Attach the apple behind the Pop-Its™ Apple using a brass fastener. Turn the hidden apple into view, then read the riddle. The answer is behind the Pop-Its Apple™. Some examples of riddles are:

- I grow on a tree. You can put me on a stick and dip me in caramel. What am I? (A Candy Apple)
- I am a fruit. My skin is full of vitamins and I am juicy inside. What am I? (An Apple)
- I am on the outside of an apple. I am red, yellow, or green. What am I? (Apple Skin)
- I am small and brown. You can find me inside an apple. What am I? (Apple Seeds)
- I am straight and strong. Apples use me to hang from a tree. What am I? (An Apple Stem)
- If you dip an apple in me, it becomes an extra-healthy snack. What am I? (Peanut Butter)
